### CRIME ALERT - OUTRAGE OF MODESTY

Several reports of outrage of modesty involving female domestic workers as victims were reported in your neighbourhood. It is believed that the culprit would normally loiter around HDB neighbourhoods while looking out for potential victims. Upon spotting his victim, he would follow her discretely into the lift. Once the lift is in motion, the culprit would trick the victim by suddenly pointing out that there is a cockroach on the victim before molesting her.

2 The description of the suspect is as follows:

- Male Indian in his late teens;
- About 1.7 - 1.8m tall; &
- Last seen wearing T-shirt, short & carrying a blue/black haversack.

3 Police would like to remind the public to remain vigilant and alert at all times. While Police and the members of Citizens-On-Patrol (COP) will be stepping up our patrols to deter these crimes, you may wish to adopt the following measures to avoid becoming a victim of crime:

- a. Be aware and alert of your surroundings. If someone stands exceptionally close to you, or if you suspect that you are being followed, remain calm and proceed to a more crowded area to seek assistance;
- b. Avoid taking short-cuts through dark and deserted places. Keep to well-lit areas where there is greater human traffic;
- c. Do not enter the lift with a stranger. Let the stranger take the lift first and wait for the next one;
- d. Arrange to meet your friends to perform relevant errands together; For example, picking up children; and
- e. Carry a shrill alarm to call for help in times of emergency.
